

Data Privacy Notice

Pursuant to the Article 13, Section 1 and 2 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (EU Journal of Laws, L. 119/1 of 4 May 2016, s. 1, as amended), hereinafter referred to as "GDPR", I hereby inform you that:

- 1) The Warsaw Film School, located at ul. G. Zajęczka 7, 01- 518 in Warsaw, is the Data Administrator of your personal data;
- 2) The Data Administrator appointed an Inspector General for the Protection of Personal Data (IOD); IOD can be contacted at: iod@szkolafilmowa.pl.
- 3) Your personal data shall be processed in order to:
 - a) share information on the activity of the Warsaw Film School (hereinafter referred to as "WSF);
 - b) impart information on the events organized by WSF;
 - c) communicate information on enrolments.
- 4) Your consent is the sole legal basis for processing of your personal data (Article 6, Section 1, a) of GDPR) for the purpose specified in the consent.
- 5) Your personal data shall be received by: entities entitled to receive personal data under separate laws, authorised employees/associates of the Data Controller, providers of technical and administrative services. Recipients of your personal data can also include entities and bodies entitled to receive your data, only if necessary and according to generally applicable laws;
- 6) Your personal data shall not be transferred to third countries;
- 7) Your personal data shall be stored:
 - a) for the period of five years since the date of granting your consent or until you submit a request to have your personal data erased, withdraw your consent for personal data processing, request restriction of personal data, object to its processing or demand its transfer;
 - b) for the period necessary to protect legitimate interests of the Data Controller.
- 8) You have the right to access your personal data, demand its rectification, erasure, restriction of its processing, to have it transferred and to object to its processing.
- 9) You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Authority, if the Data Controller processes your personal data in violation of the personal data protection laws.
- 10) Providing personal data is voluntary.
- 11) Your personal data shall not be subject to automated decision making, including profiling.
